**BACKGROUND:**

Writer was dispatched to Ft Harrison Av / Court St reference Scientology security following a trespasser. As Writer was enroute Writer was told that security was at Pierce St/Drew St with the trespasser. Sgt J. Egger arrived on the scene first. As Sgt Egger arrived, he observed the alleged trespasser, a W/M juvenile. The juvenile would not stop for Sgt Egger and Sgt Egger held onto him until Officer P. Egger arrived.

**INVESTIGATION:**

Writer first observed the juvenile, Carlo D'Aubrey sitting on a concrete slab with his arms hiding his face. Carlo would not lift his face to look at Writer. He was crying and Writer could get him to mumble a few words.

Writer spoke to security guard, Bill Johnson who stated that someone reported Carlo looking in a window. Johnson stated at first he didn't see Carlo but later observed him by a car. He stated he told Carlo to stop, but Carlo kept walking away. He stated that Carlo's mother is a staff member with the Church of Scientology. He told Writer that Carlo's mother was being treated at Largo Medical Center for a stomach problem.

Writer went back and questioned Carlo about his problem. Carlo told Writer that he lived at Hacienda Gardens with some other guys. He told Writer he did not want to go home, nor did he want to go with Security. He told Writer that he left his job and the security guards harass him. Writer eventually convinced Carlo to come with Writer.

Writer transported Carlo to C.P.D. where Writer obtained the following information. Carlo told writer that he didn't want to be in Clearwater, but he didn't have any other particular place in mind to live. He told writer he quit his job because it was boring. He stated he didn't go to school, but worked maintenance for the Church. He told writer that he would work from 0830 hours to 2200 hours. He would earn thirty dollars a week. When asked if he would get in trouble with the Church, he stated he didn't know. When asked if he would get in trouble with his mom, he stated he did know and that he hadn't seen her in a week or two. Writer asked him how he got the job, and he stated he was assigned to the job. He said he took enough courses to work a different job, but he ended up with the job he didn't want. Writer asked him if anyone mistreats him and he stated no.

He told writer that his father Doug D'Aubrey W/M 2/16/57 lives somewhere in Manchester, England. Carlo wants to see his father, but the Church will not allow it. Carlo stated that he used to live in L.A. approx 5 yrs. ago. His father had a high position in the church and would visit him and his mother on weekends. He stated one weekend he was told that his father ran away. His father supposedly had committed some high crime within the Church. His mother then had to divorce his father because his father went against the church values. Carlo asked his mother if he could see his father.

but his mother never responded to him. Carlo said his father would have to get permission from the International Justice Chief before he could see Carlo.

Writer asked Carlo if anyone can leave the church. He stated that there is a right way to leave the church. He said that the ACD Chief would have to put the person who wanted to leave on a special form called the "rotten form." That person would then have to do certain steps to get out and would have to go through a security checks. They also would have to answer certain questions and have a forwarding address.

Writer asked Carlo if he would like to somehow locate his father. He stated that someone in the church told him his father was in England and he would like to find his father but he is not allowed. Carlo stated that he did not know what type of work his father does, but that his father and mother were from England.

Carlo told writer that his mother works in finance. He stated that he did not know what her statistic was, but stated a statistic was like a condition. He gave writer an example by saying the more money she makes the better her condition. IF she makes less money her condition lowers.

Carlo told writer that the church owes him 3 weeks pay. He stated they were making him feel like he wasn't

Carlo told writer that he might have to go to a "condition formal." He told writer that a condition formal would be a course where he would learn how to communicate learn what was needed and then learn how to produce. He told writer that if things were going good that would be good production. He told writer that every job has a different statistic and production depends on the job.

Writer, while interviewing Carlo was told that security was at the front desk and they wanted to take Carlo. Writer contacted Carlo's mother, at Largo Medical Center. Ms. D'Aubrey made arrangements for a Rusty Hilton to take custody of Carlo. She told writer she would make arrangements for Rusty to bring Carlo to the hospital on 4/1/91.

Writer took a photo of Carlo and released him to CPD to Rusty Hilton.
