I was promised that if I took the courses and followed the 24 program that I would receive the benefits of freedom from 25 emotional, physical and mental pain and distress, as well as 26 career success. Furthermore, I was promised that if the promised 27 results were not achieved all monies would be refunded.
- 28 16. The promised results were not achieved. To the contrary,

following my involvement with the Church of Scientology I was released from two separate positions with Phoenix Union High School District. I am currently unemployed, being unable to find a job. I am not free from emotional, physical or mental pain. In fact, I feel that the Church itself was a cause of much emotional, physical and mental pain, not to mention the huge financial loss which I incurred.
