Dear Chery,

I have come to the point of my processing, at somewhat over 200 hours, when I have had a major cognition; that I do not want to proceed any further in Scientology. This comes as a result of some major realizations that have come to me, as I have been out of processing this week, following completion of the PTS rundown:

1. I have been with Wilma constantly for the last few days and have not been restimmed by her. I do not believe I am PTS to her.
2. My psychosomatics only return when I get near the Org.; I am either PTS to the Org. or to the activity of auditing.
3. The auditing had aberated my thinking, that I was put in danger, last week, of losing my steady and responsible job, due to psychological fitness for duty, AND WASN'T EVEN CONCERNED ABOUT IT!
4. I had become so paranoid about Scientology and my own personal safety, that I was carrying a gun around for self defense!
5. Due to my participation in Scientology, I was jeopardizing my good standing in the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, the Lord's true church on the face of the earth today and thru the millenium. I was in danger of losing the sealing of my late wife to me and of doing the endowments and other ordinances necessary to my eternal future. Scientology is only a tool with which to control your mind. The Plan of Salvation in the Mormon Church is the mechanism that everyone, even LKH, will have to use to return to God. I can do it without the tool, if only I persist in faith in Jesus Christ and obedience to the commandments.
6. Most of the differences between Wilma and me have been as a result of her concern about my activity in the Church of Scientology. Of course, she has been compromised lately, by the abuse of alcohol which was responsible for her attack on me last month. Since I have been gone, she has received many blessings from the Mormons and has been keeping the Word of Wisdom. She will be baptised in the church, hopefully, by me, next weekend, and be sealed to me in one year, with my late wife.
7. I believe that I had gone past my own determinism in Scientology practice, having been unduly influenced by the staff, the propaganda, and my own natural inclination to manifest psychosomatics, confirmed by two psychological studies of me taken 3 years apart.
8. I appreciate all of the efforts that you and your staff have taken in my behalf; I am now ready to discontinue any further work.

Per the tech., I know that Scientology will honor requests for refunds, for services not yet received. Therefore, this is to respectfully request the following refunds:

1. 200 Hours Auditing = \$37,200 - \$37,200 (services received) =	-0-
2. Scholarship (Grd.5) = approx. \$9,000 - 1t \$1,000*	= approx. \$8,000
3. Training Materials = approx. \$5,000 - nothing (all unused) =	approx. \$5,000
4. 200 Hours Auditing = \$37,200 - approx. \$7128 (serv. rec'd) =	approx. \$30,072
<u>AOLA - I am asking you to pursue this for me, since you and David jointly reged. me for 4. and this, 5., below:</u>	
5. AOLA (OT-1 thru OT-5) = \$54,730 - nothing (all unused) =	\$54,730
Total = -----	= approx. \$97,802

I understand, also per the tech., that this request, if honored, will permanently, in this life prevent me from ever receiving any further processing or other services from Scientology. Obviously, I am refusing them now and have no intention of taking them up in the future; so this is also my wish. Please honor it.

Thank you again for all of you services so faithfully rendered to me in the past. I'm sure that they have rendered me some service and benefit, if, perhaps only insight into myself.
