Nigeria is the most populous country in Africa with a population of 101 million. The average Nigerian family has nearly 7 children and 39% of the children in Nigeria are undernourished. 81 out of every 1000 children die before they are one year old.

If Robert Minton is providing the money that is financing this film, that money comes from the mouths of starving Nigerian children. The Government of Nigeria brought criminal charges against Minton on June 23rd for fraud, forgery of financial documents, and the laundering of money. Minton is charged with skimming millions of dollars off financial transactions in dealings with the former dictatorship of Nigeria which led to the loss of some \$6 billion to the Nigerian economy. The new democratic government of Nigeria is taking steps to recover this money and deal with the perpetrators of this fraud against their people.

One hour of each cast member's wages, if paid for by these ill-gotten funds, would feed a Nigerian family for a week.
